You can pay for lessons with Cash or Check (made payable to: Maplewood Recreation Department). Lesson cancellations must be made 24 hours in advance and will be rescheduled. Lessons given to children are for **ages 6 and over only**.

We offer Two types of lessons:

Instructional Lessons - Traditional lessons with an instructor who will provide instruction on strokes and strategy. Basic outline of the lesson is - Warm-up, diagnostics, review of recommended change to current stroke and review of correct technique, corrective instruction/practice.

Hitting Lessons - Rallying and/or point play drills with an instructor. Any instructional advice will be summative with the focus of the lesson on practice.

Lessons can be taken at Memorial Park or Walter Park when available. Each instructor will have different availability. Instructors can be contacted directly by email or text to determine a lesson time that is convenient for both.
